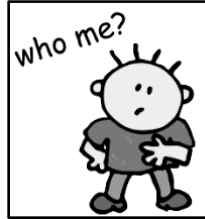

## ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF ANGLICAN PARISH

### For all regular attenders at Milton or Ulladulla churches

The Annual General meeting of the parish will be held today Sunday 30th March at 11:00 am after a combined service. Information on those who have already been nominated to positions on the Parish Council is included in this bulletin and available at the back of the church. Others can still be nominated even at the meeting itself but they must have agreed to stand. Two wardens are elected by parishioners, and one is nominated by the rector. The role of the wardens is to be legally responsible for church property and finances, payment of staff and to cause decisions regarding these matters to be implemented. They are ex officio members of parish council. A motion to elect 6 Parish council members will be presented at the meeting. In addition, the rector can appoint two. The responsibility of parish councillors is to determine matters of policy regarding finances and property, to determine salaries and stipends within diocesan guidelines, and to confer with the minister generally in the conduct of parish work and spiritual welfare and to make recommendations to him on such matters. People are also elected to find a new minister if a vacancy occurs and to take part in the general diocesan parliament, called the Sydney Diocesan Synod. All who belong to this church can come and join in! That's you!



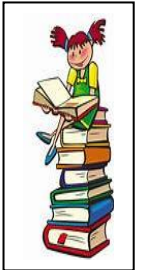
## EASTER IS A TIME OF CELEBRATION
